
Subject: Release of Grant under 1st proviso to Article 275(1) of the Constitution during 2013-14 to the State Government of Jharkhand - sanction of 1st Installment (Capital Assets-Non-recurring)

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to convey the sanction of the President to the grants-in-aid (non-recurring) amounting to Rs. 8836.16 lakh under Article 275 (1) of the Constitution of India and to the release of 1st installment of Rs.6627.12 lakh (Rupees sixty six crore twenty seven lakh twelve thousand only), as payment of Central Assistance during 2013-14 towards Capital Assets for taking up the following activities as mentioned by the State Government in its letter No. 2/Art.275(1)/-27/2013-1028 dated 14-05-2013

2. The Ministry has sanctioned the setting up of two new EMRS at Simdega and Jamshedpur at the cost of Rs.1200.00 lakh for each EMRS. This is subject to the condition that the State Government will construct these EMRSs in accordance with the revised guidelines which, interalia, includes land availability of at least 15 acres of land out of which up to 3.5 acres may be used for the construction purposes and the remaining area must be maintained properly and a reasonable portion may be earmarked for sports/ games.

3. No UC is due for rendition for releases made up to 2011-12.

4. You are requested to advise RBI, CAS, Nagpur for crediting the above mentioned amount to the account of the Government of Jharkhand in accordance with procedure laid down in the Ministry of Finance's OM No. 2(45)/76-Spl Cell dated 30.8.1976 as modified by OM of even number dated 16.9.1976.

6. The entire assistance is subject to adjustment on the basis of the audited figures of expenditure for the State Annual Plan 2013-14.
7. The State Government will implement the projects within the amount released by the Ministry during 2012-13 and keeping in view spirit of the guideline laid down on Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution vide its letter No. 14011/9/2001-SG&C dated 2-7-2002 & D.O. letter No. 14020/2/2008-SG-1 dated 30.01.2008 and other instructions issued from time to time. A copy of the projects implemented by the State Government is required to be sent by the State Government to the Ministry. While taking up / implementing the projects submitted by the State Government vide their letter dated 07.09.2012 (received through e-mail), the State Government would ensure that:-
- i. construction component of the project is based on the schedule of rates of CPWD/PWD or any other scheduled of rates approved by a competent authority.
 - ii projects/s has the clearance of the State Government from the technical / financial / administrative angles.
8. The State Government is to transfer fund immediately within 30 days to the project implementing agencies and a copy of the fund transfer order may also be sent to this Ministry. It may be ensured that the grants are used for the purpose for which they are sanctioned after following the due procedure in a transparent manner and obtaining all necessary clearances as required under the various Central/State Acts, Rules and Regulations etc.
9. The progress reports of every quarter should be furnished indicating the physical and financial progress as per prescribed format already circulated. A Certificate of actual utilization of the grants received for the purpose for which it was received, may be furnished to the Ministry within 12 months of the closure of the financial year by the State Government.
10. This sanction issues in exercise of the delegated powers in consultation with Integrated Finance of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs vide their Diary No.882/JS&FA/2013 dated 19-9-2013.
11. Certified that this sanction has been noted at S. No. ~~---~~³⁸ in the register of grants.


