Subject: Monthly Summary of Principal Activities for August, 2019.

This is regarding important activities of Ministry of Tribal Affairs during the month of August, 2019.

2. Ministry of Tribal Affairs and Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India (TRIFED) organized Tribal Festival 'Adi Mahotsava' in Leh (Ladakh) during the month, from 17th August, 2019 to 25th August, 2019. The theme of the festival was "**Celebration of the Spirit of Tribal Culture, Craft, Cuisine and Commerce**". Over 200 tribal artisans from different States participated in the Aadi Mahotsav, which is an effort to take tribal commerce to the next level of digital and electronic transactions. Scheduled Tribes Finance and Development Corporation (NSTFDC) also participated in Adi Mahotsava.
3. "National Scheduled Tribes Finance and Development Corporation (NSTFDC)" disbursed loan of Rs.10.91 crores as on 31.08.2019 for the year 2019-20. The total Annual target for the year, 2019-20 is Rs.228.00 crores.
4. The National Scheduled Tribes Finance and Development Corporation (NSTFDC) organized an Awareness camp at Villumpuram, Tiruvannamalai district in Tamil Nadu and Chakkittapara, Kozhikode district in Kerala during the month of August, 2019 to disseminate information about NSTFDC schemes.
5. Incumbency details of all posts in the Ministry and its organizations, falling under ACC purview have been updated on AVMS. There has been no case in which ACC directions have not been complied with.
6. Video Conference with all the State Governments to discuss the pending issues was held during the month.
7. A new TRI Building was inaugurated at Dehradun (Uttarakhand) on 21.08.2019 by Hon'ble Minister, Tribal Affairs.
8. Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS) Kalsi (Uttarakhand) team performed group song in a function in the honour of Freedom Fighters in Rashtrapati Bahawan during the month.
9. This Ministry has observed "Swatchhata Pakhwada", from 1st August to 15th August 2019 and sensitize its employees on the "Disposal of Plastic waste".
10. As per information received from State Governments till 30.04.2019, 42,37,853 claims (40,89,035 individual and 1,48,818 community claims) have been filed and 19,64,048 titles (18,87,894 individual and 76,154 community claims) have been distributed. A total of 37,17,552 (87.72%) claims have been disposed of under the ST and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006.
11. During the month of August 2019, 152 E-files have been created by this Ministry in e-office.
